Statement of Faith

(Summary)

We are an independent, fundamental, Bible believing and Bible teaching church.

WE BELIEVE that the Bible is the inspired Word of God and is inerrant and the only rule for faith and practice.

WE BELIEVE that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, was born of a virgin, died on the cross for our sins, was buried and rose again the third day. We believe that He is ascended and is seated at the Father's right hand where He now intercedes for all true believers.

WE BELIEVE in the Pre-millennial, Pre-tribulation rapture of the Church. We believe that the earth will then go through seven years of tribulation and then Jesus will return to earth with His saints to set up His millennial kingdom.

WE BELIEVE that salvation is by grace through faith apart from works and that every true believer is eternally secure.

WE BELIEVE in one God who is eternal and who exists in three Persons: The Father, Son and the Holy Spirit, and these three are co-equal.

WE BELIEVE that man was created in the image of God, but in Adam's fall, every person is a sinner both by birth and by practice. We believe that every person must be born again in order to be redeemed and saved from eternal punishment.

Pulpit Committee Report, January 29, 2012

As mentioned in previous reports, the Pulpit Committee focused our search on our top five applicants. In early January, one of the applicants withdrew his application.

As of this last week, the Pulpit Committee has completed interviews with the remaining top four applicants.

For each applicant we held a preliminary telephone interview, and later a video interview via Skype with the applicant and his wife.

We remain very excited and optimistic about these applicants. These are men who have excellent teaching and shepherding skills, and they and their wives appear to make excellent teams.

Our next step, which comes on Tuesday, is to pray and vote for each candidate. Our hope is that multiple applicants will receive 100% affirmative votes from the Pulpit Committee.

Then, our next step will be to contact all of the references provided for these applicants. We will also ask these references for further references, and contact those. We will also do background checks.

Assuming we do not find any issues that would disqualify the applicants from these references, we will then vote which applicant we wish to come and be our Candidate before the congregation.

We do not have a concrete completion date, but we are working hard and meeting twice per week.

Again, we feel very positive and excited about these applicants. We have momentum and look forward to bringing our Candidate to Chelan to meet with and speak to the congregation as soon as possible.

The Pulpit Committee asks for your continued prayers for the LORD's direction, for unity, for wisdom, for endurance, for patience, and for the LORD's guidance and protection of each of our applicant.
